

Bobcat West

Bobcat West now offers the first three models released in the new Bobcat compact tractor line. Six additional models will be introduced later this year.

The three available models are the Bobcat CT120, CT225 and CT230. These compact tractors are designed to help farmers, ranchers, commercial landscapers, groundskeepers and homeowners with acreage tackle a variety of tasks. The machines can be used with Bobcat implements, including an angle blade, box blade, finish mower, post-hole digger, seeder and tine rake, as well as a front-end loader and attachments.

The Bobcat CT120 compact tractor, which features a 21-horsepower diesel engine, provides customers with legendary Bobcat productivity on small farms and commercial property. Its compact size of 44 inches wide, along with agriculture tires, make it perfect for working in and

around barns and sheds, mowing, property maintenance and light-duty work.

The Bobcat CT225 compact tractor has a 25-hp diesel engine for labor-saving productivity and all-around versatility. The compact tractor is strong enough to make tough work easy and small enough to work in tight areas. The third model in the initial launch is the Bobcat CT230. This 30-hp compact tractor has the power for heavy-duty loading, tilling or working with a box blade. Like the CT225, the CT230 is strong yet small enough to work in confined areas.

All Bobcat compact tractors feature four-wheel drive for traveling over and working in rough terrain and come with hydrostatic transmissions for easy operation. The CT120 features two travel speed ranges, while the CT225 and CT230 come with three-speed travel. The two larger compact tractor models are also equipped with a premium three-point hitch design for

easy implement changes.

In line with Bobcat Co.'s commitment to offer customers durable and reliable equipment, the compact tractors have sleek hoods and side panels made of tough, durable steel, and their design provides superior visibility to the front of the tractors. Standard comfort and safety features include a spark arrester muffler, horn, brake lights and operator's handbook, as well as an optional Bobcat suspension seat and

a fully retractable seat belt.

Fifty years ago, Bobcat introduced a compact front-end loader that became the world's first skid-steer loader, later adopting the familiar "Bobcat" brand. Bobcat Co. leads the world in the design, manufacture and distribution of compact equipment.
